Recognise this is not Formula 1

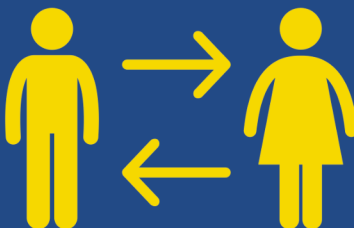
# COVID-19
